A Word That Takes the Place of a Noun

<u>Personal Pronouns</u>: *I, me, you, your, they, us, who, it we*

Possessive Pronouns: my, your, its, our, his, her, their

<u>Demonstrative Pronouns:</u> this, that, these, those <u>Indefinite Pronouns</u>: another, both, any, all, several, each, few, none

Reflexive Pronouns: ends with self or selves—himself, herself, itself...

Interrogative Pronouns: who, whom, whose, which, what (begins a question)

Intensive: ends with self or selves and adds emphasis to a subject

Relative: who, whom, which, whose, that
